- 7. **Provide as much information** and documentation as you can from the property sellers to your solicitor.
- 8. You will need to **be patient**, especially if you are in a chain.
- 9. Make sure that you have **everything in place** that you need, such as mortgage finance before proceeding.
- 10. **Ask questions**, check documents, make sure you are satisfied with the customer service you are receiving.
